

Transition to distance learning

November 9, 2020

Due to the latest epidemiological measures, higher education institutions are moving to distance education, with students having to move out of dormitories. Distance learning applies to both lessons and assessment (mid-term exams). Detailed rules for the rest of the study period, the retake/late completion period and the exam period will be made by the university and faculty management in the following days as follows:

1. New measures and rules will be announced on the evening of *November 10, 2020 (Tuesday)* based on the text of the government decree published in the Hungarian Gazette, We kindly ask for the patience of the teachers and students of the VIK.
2. *On Tuesday, November 10, 2020*, education will continue according to the current order, lessons can and will be held.
3. *On Wednesday, November 11, 2020*, only distance education is possible.
4. *On Thursday, November 12, 2020*, there will be break due to the Scientific Student Circle Conference, therefore no study sessions will take place in any form.
5. *On Friday, November 13, 2020* the form of education can only be announced on the basis of the government decree and university rules.
